Minimum Connection Time:

MCT is as per airline rules. Please allow enough time for passengers to go between the airplane and the train station. Connection time is included from airport to train station in GDS.

Eligibility:

Infants 2 years of age and under ride free without a ticket if no seat is required. The infant must be accompanied on all services in the same compartment by an adult.

Child fare available for children under the age of 16 years.

No group bookings allowed.

No applicable discounts for airline staff.

No unaccompanied minors permitted.

Refunds are according to Airline Tariff Rules.

Services:

Travel on Great Western Railway in either First class or in Standard class.

First class has comfortable seats and tables with outlets and USB ports, free Wi-Fi, and complimentary refreshments, as well as, access up to two hours prior to departure to the First-class lounge at London Paddington station and Cardiff Central station.

Pets:

Up to two pets, cats, dogs, or other small domestic animals, are allowed to be brought onto the train. Pets must be in a pet carrier. Dogs must be on a lead or in a rigid pet carrier. Pets are not allowed on the seats.

Check-in Process:


Check-in is essential to ensure a smooth travel experience.

Passengers must check-in to retrieve their actual travel documents. Check-in can be done beginning 72-hours prior to departure. Check-in is done on https://check-in.accesrail.com/#/step1 (Figure 4) using the passenger's name as it appears in the booking and either the booking reference or 13-digit ticket number.

Passengers who arrive/depart from Heathrow
Airport will receive two documents when they
check-in, the ticket for their journey on GWR
(Figure 3) and the ticket for Heathrow Express for
their journey to/from Heathrow Airport to London
Paddington Station (Figure 5). The Heathrow
Express departs every 15 minutes and has a travel
time of 15 minutes making it an easy way for
passengers to reach London Paddington Station.

If passengers arrive at London Gatwick Airport, they will take a GWR train from the airport with a connection via Reading Station.

Seat reservations are not included.





How to Get to the Train:

At **Heathrow Airport** in London, passengers will have to make their way to the Heathrow Express stop. Passengers can catch the Heathrow Express from Terminal 2&3, with a 15-minute journey to Paddington station, or from Terminal 5, with an extra 6 minutes added to the journey downtown.

Passengers who arrive at Terminal 4 can make their way to Terminal 2&3 via a free inter-terminal shuttle that takes approximately 4 minutes. Please see interactive map for Heathrow Airport for directions to the Heathrow Express station.

Once on the Heathrow Express, passengers will be brought to London Paddington Station where they can transfer to their long-haul train ride.

Passengers departing London Paddington Station can take the Heathrow Express which departs every 15 minutes to Heathrow Airport. Passengers can then depart the Heathrow Express at either Terminal 2&3 or Terminal 5. If passengers

need to reach Terminal 4, they can take the free inter-terminal airport transfer.

Passengers departing from **London Gatwick Airport** can reach the railway station that is located at the South Terminal. If passengers arrive at the North Terminal, they can take the free airport shuttle to the South Terminal that should only take a few minutes to reach.

Luggage:

GWR luggage rules apply. It is the passenger's responsibility to collect their checked bags from the airport and carry them to their respective train and vice-versa. Customer is responsible for their own baggage during the train journey.





On-board Meals:

Great Western Railways offers complimentary food and drinks at your seat for First class passengers on some trains. Passengers can select from tea and coffee, juices, sodas, and water, biscuits and cakes, and crisps. Please note that catering is not offered on the following routes: Penzance – Cardiff/Gloucester, Paddington – Newbury/Bedwyn, or Paddington – Oxford, Reading – Gatwick.

Mobility Assistance:

Mobility assistance must be requested from GWR at least 2 hours prior to the departure of the train. The Passenger Assistance Team is available 24 hours, 7 days a week (except for December 25 and December 26). Requests can be made through their <u>passengers</u> assistance form, by calling +0800 197 1329, or texting +18001 0800 197 1329.

Delays:

In case of train delays, passengers must contact the issuing airline carrier for assistance.

In case of flight delays, passengers can travel on any departure on the date shown on the ticket.

SSR Message:

Please note that the SSR message will contain check-in information.

FAQ:

- Is GWR a BUS or TRN?
 GWR is a train (TRN) service.
- 2. Do I have to check-in?

 Yes, passengers must check-in in order to receive their actual travel document which they will use to board the train.
- Can I upgrade my ticket?
 Unfortunately, passengers are unable to upgrade their tickets at the station or while on the train.
